The weather was good which meant no howling winds to contend with. We had 13 shooters of which five used scope equipped rifles and the rest used iron sights

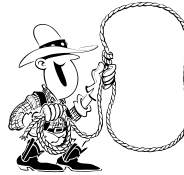

## **FIFTH SUNDAY LONG RANGE BENCH REST PISTOL MATCH 6-30-13**

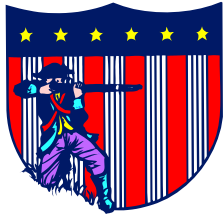

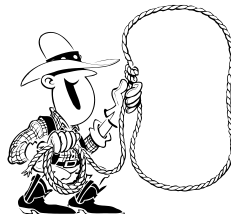
Between the two Pistoleros, Bill Hamilton bested John Wostal to the tune of 13 to 8.
