

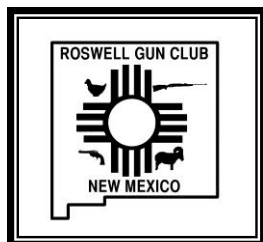

## REGULAR LOW POWER MATCH 06/02/12

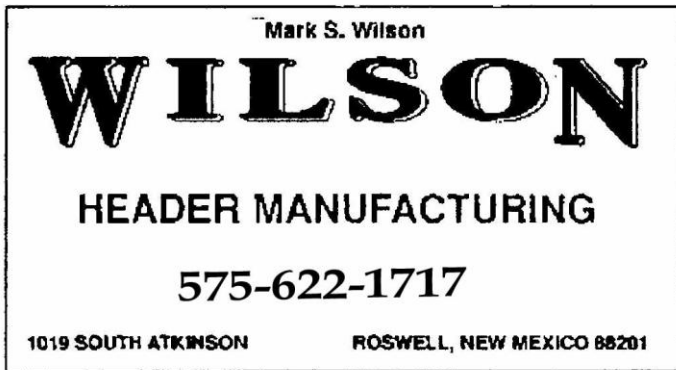

Today we had 13 shooters out and, as usual, a stiff wind.

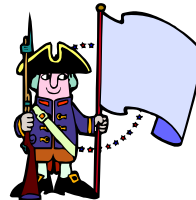
