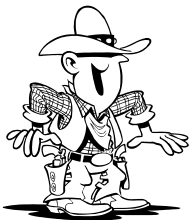

MISSING ANIMAL TARGETS

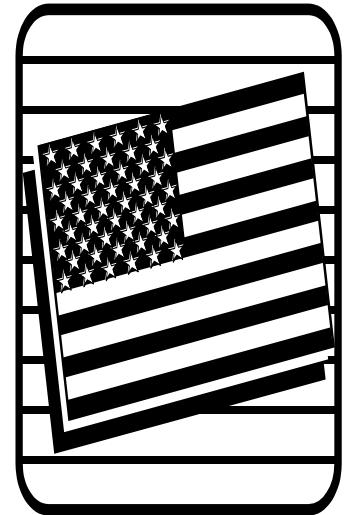
